1. **Laurent Perrier Brut NV** **40.95**  
Hints of citrus linger in this delicate, well made, easy drinking champagne - on its own, with food or anytime - delicious

2. **Moët et Chandon Brut Impérial NV** **43.50**  
A creamy, dry and crisp champagne, known by all. Consistent quality and very reliable

3. **Bollinger Special Cuvée NV** **51.00**  
A rich full flavoured champagne with good bottle age - a little bit special!

### Rosé

4. **Taittinger Prestige Rosé NV** **53.25**  
Delicate salmon pink in colour and the aromas of wild strawberries, this Prestige Rosé is soft and elegant

## Sparkling

5. **Castillo Perelada Brut Reserva NV** **17.65**  
Quality sparkling wine from Northern Spain, made by a top producer, an opportunity to celebrate anytime!

## White Wines

### The New World

6. **Rocheburg Chenin Blanc 2009/10** **16.55**  
A good example of South Africa's classic grape, with an abundance of tropical and citrus fruit, this fresh, dry white is excellent everyday drinking

7. **Boonaburra Chardonnay 2010** **17.45**  
This full flavoured yet soft and elegant Australian white is pale straw in colour with the aroma of peaches and apricots

8. **Añuela Sauvignon Blanc 2010 'Casablanca Valley'** **17.75**  
Just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean the Casablanca Valley produces some of the very best Chilean Sauvignon. The intense aromas of fresh herb and apple, together with the flavour of exotic fruits and ripe pineapple make this a smooth, lively and distinctive zesty wine.

9. **Grant Burge Zerk Old Vine Semillon Viognier 2009** **19.25**  
Vines over 70 years old make this full flavoured complex wine. Vibrant palestraw in colour with the aromas of tropical fruit and hints of guava, just a touch of vanilla from the new French oak. Soft and clean with a crisp freshness, it is long, smooth and creamy on the finish. Drink now or will mature for up to 10 years.

**10. Jackson Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2009 'Marlborough'** **21.25**  
An immediate neighbour of that world famous wine named after a 'bay'! This is certainly in the same league, classic Sauvignon at its best - confirms New Zealand's reputation for delicious Sauvignon

## Europe

**11. Viognier de Pennautier 2009 - Vin de Pays d'Oc** **17.45**  
An eruption of fresh peach, passion fruit and apricots abound in this smooth delicious wine which is made from grapes grown on the cool slopes of the Montagne Noir.

**12. Fiano 2009 'Mandarossa'** **17.85**  
From the beautiful green hills of Sicily, attractive golden yellow in colour and on the nose exotic fruits burst into life, and the finish crisp and refreshing, a must for the ambitious - is this the new Pinot Grigio?

**13. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine 'Sur Lie' 2009** **17.75**  
**'Domaine de la Rinière'**  
A true domaine bottled 'sur lie', which gives the added flavour, prickle and freshness sought in this delicate dry Loire wine

**14. Cune Monopole 'Dry White' 2009** **18.45**  
This crisp and fresh dry white wine is made entirely from the white Viura grape. It has aromas of ripe citrus fruit and is the perfect partner for fish and seafood, or on its own any time!

**15. Mâcon Blanc Lugny 2008/09 'Les Charmes'** **21.25**  
This wine is produced in the heart of Burgundy from the Chardonnay grapes grown in the limestone hills near Macon, fresh full flavoured with a lingering finish

**16. Pouilly Fumé 2009 Domaine du Petit Soumard** **24.25**  
The sauvignon grape at its best, a crisp refreshing wine offering all the quality and style one would expect from this top Loire wine pleasure on any occasion

## Rosé Wines

**17. Mateus Rose** **15.70**  
Back by popular request - the all time favourite!  
Well-known strawberry pink Rosé wine, medium dry in style with a soft petillance

**18. Terra Andina Rosé 2010** **15.85**  
From the hills of the Andes it is deep pink in colour with the aromas of fresh summer fruits and the flavour of sweet ripe cherries, smooth and soft - anytime drinking.

**19. Sutter Home White Zinfandel 'Blush' 2009** **15.85**  
Stylish medium dry wine from one of the better 'Napa Valley'

producers, known as a 'blush' wine having been left in contact with the red grape skins, medium dry in style - a delicious aperitif.

- 20. Domaine Houchart Rosé 2009 'Sainte Victoire'** **17.75**  
Strawberry pink in colour this fresh elegant rosé has the flavour of ripe summer fruits with a hint of white peach, soft and delicate from one of Provence's best properties

## **Red Wines**

### **The New World**

- 21. Boonaburra Shiraz Cabernet 2009/10** **17.45**  
Aromas of vanilla, cherry and ripe plums, this classic Australian red has the flavours of summer berries and just a hint of oak
- 22. Willow Bridge Cabernet Merlot 2008/09** **19.75**  
The aromas of ripe black cherries and summer berry fruits and just a 'little' oak make this elegant wine a true pleasure on any occasion
- 23. 'Cycles Gladiator' Cabernet Sauvignon 2007/08** **19.75**  
Big, robust red, this new Californian has layers of raspberry, plum and wild currant flavours, balanced with firm tannins giving a long persistent finish.
- 24. Caliterra Tributo Carmenere 2008/09 'Colchagua Valley'** **19.95**  
This wine is made from grapes from specially selected lots on the Caliterra Estate, hand picked and gently crushed this wine was aged for 14 months in oak casks. Its intense aromatic flavour gives off notes of dried fruit, chocolate and hints of moist tobacco leaves. Its soft tannins deliver an excellent balance and long lasting finish.
- 25. Runnymede Island Pinot Noir 2009/10 'Marlborough'** **20.75**  
Difficult to make but after Burgundy, New Zealand does it best. This new wine from a small family property on the South Island has the aromas and flavours of ripe black cherry, soft, silky and lasting, with a gentle spicy character - drink cool, even chilled!
- 26. Peter Lehmann 'The Futures' Shiraz 2004** **22.75**  
Classic Barossa Shiraz, deep red/black in colour yet with a soft bouquet of ripe berry fruit with hints of nutmeg and vanilla. Matured only in French oak giving soft tannins and a mouth-filling velvety fruit finish
- ### **Europe**
- 27. Vega del Castillo 'Tempranillo' 2009** **16.15**  
The iconic Spanish red grape better known in the making of the best Riojas! Here it produces a full flavoured well balanced wine, aromas and flavours of ripe berries and just a hint of violet.
- 28. Mezzora Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2008/09** **17.45**  
Produced from the native Montepulciano grape grown in the central region of the Abruzzi, deep in colour, robust in style, it has the flavours of dark plums and chocolate
- 29. Côtes du Ventoux 2009 'Jérôme Quiot'** **17.95**

Stunning red from the Southern Rhone, big full flavoured yet with a soft round elegant finish

**30. Rioja El Coto 'Crianza' 2006/07 18.75**

A quality oak aged wine from Northern Spain's best Bodega; it is distinctive with the flavours of ripe red berries and a hint of vanilla coming from having spent some time in new oak casks

**31. Primitivo di Manduria 2008 Puglia 20.15**

From family producer Paoleo's mature vineyards situated in Salento, southern Italy. These native grapes are hand selected and picked, the result a wine that is intense ruby in colour with the aromas of wild berries and ripe cherry, full bodied with an intense fruit flavour and a gentle spicy finish from its time in small oak casks, exceptional quality.

**32. Rioja El Coto de Imaz Reserva 2004 22.25**

A stunning quality wine from one of the best Bodegas. Incredible fruit, good structure, this is one of the very best

**33. Grant Burge Holy Trinity Grenache/ Shiraz/ Mourvedre 2005/06 35.75**

Vines between 50 and 110 years old give the grapes that produce this classic Barossa Valley wine, the 'Classic' Rhone blend wine is crimson red in colour with a nose alive with the aromas of rose petals, lavender and sweet white pepper. The flavour, soft, round with wild berries and quince - long in the finish, stunning!

**34. Gevrey Chambertin 2006 Patriarche Père et Fils 39.95**

The best of Burgundy, full bodied, rich with a velvety lingering finish, a good example

**35. Château d'Angludet 2003 Margaux 50.00**

Owned by the Sichel family this stylish fragrant wine is well made and, although a young vintage, is drinking well, showing exceptional fruit and is certainly impressive
